PARTICIPANT NOTICE

PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN BENEFIT MODIFICATIONS

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

This Participant notice will advise you of certain material modifications that have been made to your Medical Plan. **This information is VERY IMPORTANT to you and your dependents.** Please take the time to read it carefully.

Effective January 1, 2010, the following changes will be made to your prescription drug plan:

NEW PRESCRIPTION BENEFIT MANAGER (PBM)

Effective for prescriptions incurred on and after January 1, 2010, the Trust will provide prescription drugs under a new prescription benefit manager, EnvisionRx.

EnvisionRx will provide **retail** and **mail order** prescription drug services to Plan Participants at the same copays that are currently being charged through RxAmerica. EnvisionRx has contracted with major retail pharmacy chains nationwide. If you use a pharmacy participating in the EnvisionRx network, the pharmacy will automatically process your claim at the time you purchase the prescription.

EnvisionRx will send a Welcome Packet to your home, which will include your new ID card as well as provide information regarding the EnvisionRx mail order home delivery service through Orchard Pharmaceutical Services.

NEW ID CARDS COMING

You will be receiving under separate cover, new identification cards to be used for medical services and/or to purchase prescription drugs. Please watch the mail for your new ID cards. When you receive your new card, please shred the old card and place the new card in your wallet.

The new identification cards you receive should be used for medical services and to purchase all prescription drugs **on and after January 1, 2010**.
