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IMPORTANT PARTICIPANT NOTICE ABOUT YOUR PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFIT

To: All Active and Retired Participants and their Dependents of the
Arizona Sheet Metal Trade Trust Fund

The Board of Trustees is pleased to announce an enhancement to your prescription drug program. The Plan's Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM), Envision Rx, now has the ability to coordinate benefits at the time of retail purchase. If your spouse has other insurance this could mean a savings to you and to the Plan when a prescription drug is purchased at your local pharmacy. With this Coordination of Benefits at the point of sale, you could leave the pharmacy with little or no out-of-pocket expense!

At the time your monthly eligibility is forwarded to Envision Rx it will be noted that your spouse has other insurance. When a prescription medication for your spouse is purchased the primary I.D. card should be presented to the pharmacy and the Arizona Sheet Metal I.D. card should be presented as the secondary carrier. If it should happen that your spouse's insurance would not cover a particular medication, the pharmacy would then submit to Envision Rx as primary. When a child is covered by the plans of both parents, the plan of the parent whose birthday occurs earliest in the year will pay first. If both parents have the same birthday, the plan which covered the parent the longest will pay first.

With the implementation of the Coordination of Benefits for prescription medication purchases at the point of sale, it is important that you keep the Administrative Office informed of any change in your spouse's primary coverage. Remember, to take full advantage of this plan enhancement, if your spouse has other insurance be sure to show her/his insurance I.D. card as primary and the Arizona Sheet Metal I.D. card as the secondary insurance.
