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SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT ARIZONA SHEET METAL TRADE TRUST FUND October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010

This is a summary of the annual report for Arizona Sheet Metal Trade Trust Fund, Employer Identification Number 86-6025729, “multiemployer” plan for the period October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insured Information

The plan had a contract with Contact Behavioral Health Services to provide managed care and an employee assistance program. The total premiums paid for the period October 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 were \$20,997.

The plan now has a contract with Mines and Associates, P.C. to provide managed care and an employee assistance program. The total premiums paid for the period January 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010 were \$22,444.

The plan has a contract with Symetra Life Insurance to pay claims incurred under the terms of the plan in excess of a threshold deductible. Total premiums paid for the period October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 were \$241,346.

The plan has a contract with United Healthcare Insurance Company to provide vision benefits. Total fees paid for the period January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 were \$59,363.

Uninsured Information

Benefits for the Medical, Dental, Vision, Life, Accidental Death and Dismemberment, and Short-Term Disability are not insured and instead are self-funded by the plan sponsor, Arizona Sheet Metal Trade Trust Fund.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$3,259,862 as of September 30, 2010, compared to \$3,409,594 as of October 1, 2009. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$149,732. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan’s assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year.

The plan had total income of \$5,989,282 including employer contributions of \$5,065,363, employee contributions of \$739,451, net losses of (\$74,232) from the sale of assets and earnings from investments of \$258,700.

Plan expenses were \$6,139,014. These expenses included \$680,494 in administrative expenses and \$5,458,520 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

Your Rights To Additional Information

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report:

1. an accountant's report;
2. financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. assets held for investment;
4. fiduciary information, including non-exempt transactions between the plan and parties-in-interest (that is, persons who have certain relationships with the plan);
5. Loans or other obligations in default;
6. transactions in excess of 5% of the plan assets; and
7. actuarial information regarding the funding of the plan.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 2400 West Dunlap Avenue, Suite 250, Phoenix, Arizona 85021, and at the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
